## MAMA JOE PROJECT

The Mama Joe Project is an initiative to reduce disparity around health and caregiving for elders with Alzheimer's disease and other dementia. Core to the project is **My Mama Joe**, *Hope & Help* a documentary film that features the personal narrative of JoeAnna "Mama Joe" Caldwell, and the family journey of providing care for a loved one living with Alzheimer's. With experts representing Harvard University, AARP, Baylor College of Medicine, Washington University in St. Louis, Alzheimer's Association and more...the film raises awareness and highlights best practices for caregiving, healthy aging and dementia navigation.

January 2025 marks the debut of The Mama Joe Project in Houston. This 2-day event includes the red-carpet premiere of the My Mama Joe, film, a series of panel discussions, the youth caregivers forum, and a health and community fair. These events are free and open to all.
